Through the fundraising efforts of the 2021 - 2022 Eastern Shore Repertory Auxiliary, we are pleased to present opportunities for student scholarships to alumni and current, active ESRT students pursuing summer theatre endeavors as well as new students interested in ESRT Summer Performance Camps or participating in our Annual Fall Show or Theatre on the Bluff.

SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS AND ALUMNI (Amount to be determined by scholarship committee): Applicants must have worked with ESRT for at least two seasons, be a high school senior, or currently enrolled in a college or conservatory program and hold at least a 3.0 GPA. This monetary gift can be applied towards tuition, books, workshops, or further training. Applicants must have a teacher, instructor, or mentor complete the recommendation form (attached) and mail it back to ESRT at the address provided on the form.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS FOR CURRENT STUDENTS:

- ESRT SUMMER CAMPS (\$325)
- NON-ESRT SUMMER PROGRAM (\$500)

Applicants must have worked with ESRT for at least one season, must be a current and active ESRT student, and must be enrolled in a 2022 summer program with ESRT or **outside of the Mobile/Baldwin County Area**. (Proof of acceptance to program must be provided.) Students should be highly motivated and show a strong interest in pursuing the performing arts. A teacher, instructor or mentor must complete the recommendation form (attached) and mail it back to ESRT at the address provided on the form.

NEW STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP:

These scholarships are for applicants who are new to ESRT. **Scholarships may be used for an ESRT Summer Performance Camp session or for production or costume fees for a student's first ESRT performance.** Students should show enthusiasm for performing and motivation to learn more about theatre.
